

Terang College would like to thank everyone for their continued support throughout these unusual circumstances. As of Tuesday 26th May, all students in F-2 and Years 11 and 12, will return to onsite learning. On Tuesday 9th June, all students in Years 3 – 10 will make the transition back to onsite learning. Please be assured that we will be taking all the necessary precautions to keep everyone safe.

Precautions we will be taking include:

- Increased cleaning throughout the day
- Keeping pupils and staff with coronavirus symptoms at home. If a child attends whilst they are unwell, they will be sent home in accordance with the Department's regular Infectious Diseases Policy.
- Hygiene Practices: frequent handwashing will be encouraged for both staff and students and hand sanitizer will be available throughout the day. Students will be asked to cough into their elbows or a tissue, place used tissues straight into the bin, avoid touching eyes, noses or mouths, not share food or drink and for safety reasons, access to drink taps will be restricted. They may only be used to refill water bottles. Students will need to bring and use their own 'named' water bottles.
- Signage will be placed in classrooms reminding students about good health and safety practices.
- Access to both campuses will be restricted.

Returning loaned devices to the College

As students return to learning on-site, we ask that the devices (iPads, computers and chargers) are returned to the College. It is important that families understand that the devices remain the College's property and that devices support the College's learning and teaching program.

Mobile Phones

The rules regarding mobile phones will remain when students return to school.

*"When students bring a mobile phone to school, Terang College will provide secure storage. Secure storage **is storage that cannot be readily accessed by those without permission to do so.** At Terang College students who choose to bring their phone to school must report to the First Aid room where they will be required to hand their device to the appointed staff member. Mobile devices can be securely stored in this area between 8:30 and 8:50am. The students can then return at the conclusion of session 6 to collect their mobile devices."*

College Uniform

When students return to school they are to wear their College uniform.
