CULTURAL EXPERIENCES

POLICY (Student)

1. RATIONALE

- 1.1. To provide an opportunity for students to experience cultural performances at the College.
- 1.2. To provide cultural experiences our students otherwise would not have been able to participate in due to distance and cost.

2. AIMS

- 2.1. The organising teacher will organise and book performances (in consultation with relevant staff) suited to the relevant year levels.
- 2.2. All programs must be suited to the particular year levels.
- 2.3. The organising teacher will notify the daily organiser, coordinators and classroom teachers through email when the booking has been confirmed, prior to the new school year.
- 2.4. All communication regarding performances/bookings MUST go through the organising teacher.
- 2.5. All performances must be of a reasonable cost. Sufficient time should be allowed for parent notification and payment (4 weeks).
- 2.6. Performances where possible should be tied to current work being done by students.

3. IMPLEMENTATION

- 3.1. Issues, actions and decisions relating to this policy will take into account Department of Education and Training policies, memos, guidelines and circulars and Government Ministerial Orders and Acts.
- 3.2. The supervising teacher is to be in charge of the bookings and arrangements.
- 3.3. Two activities per year are to be organised for the P-6 year levels.
- 3.4. An invitation may be extended to neighbouring schools and community organisations to attend performances.
- 3.5. All students are encouraged to attend.
- 3.6. Students not attending are to be fully supervised elsewhere.
- 3.7. The Daily Organiser will be responsible for the set up of the event.

4. EVALUATION

- 4.1. This policy will be reviewed as part of the College three-year review cycle.
